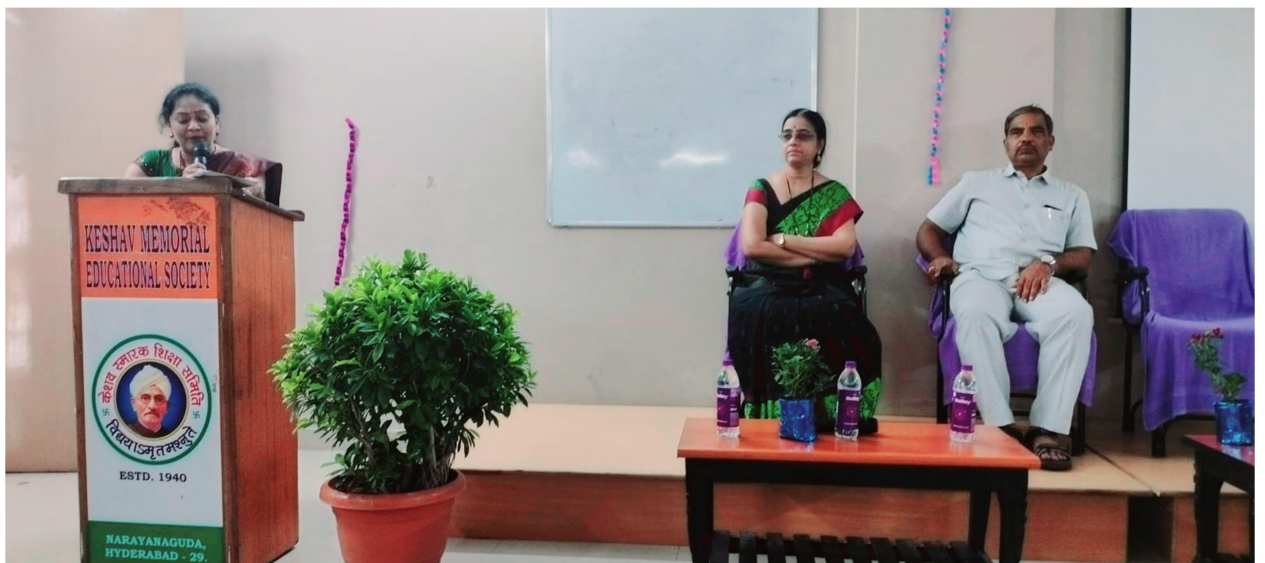

The program was followed by valedictory session where the participants received their certificates.

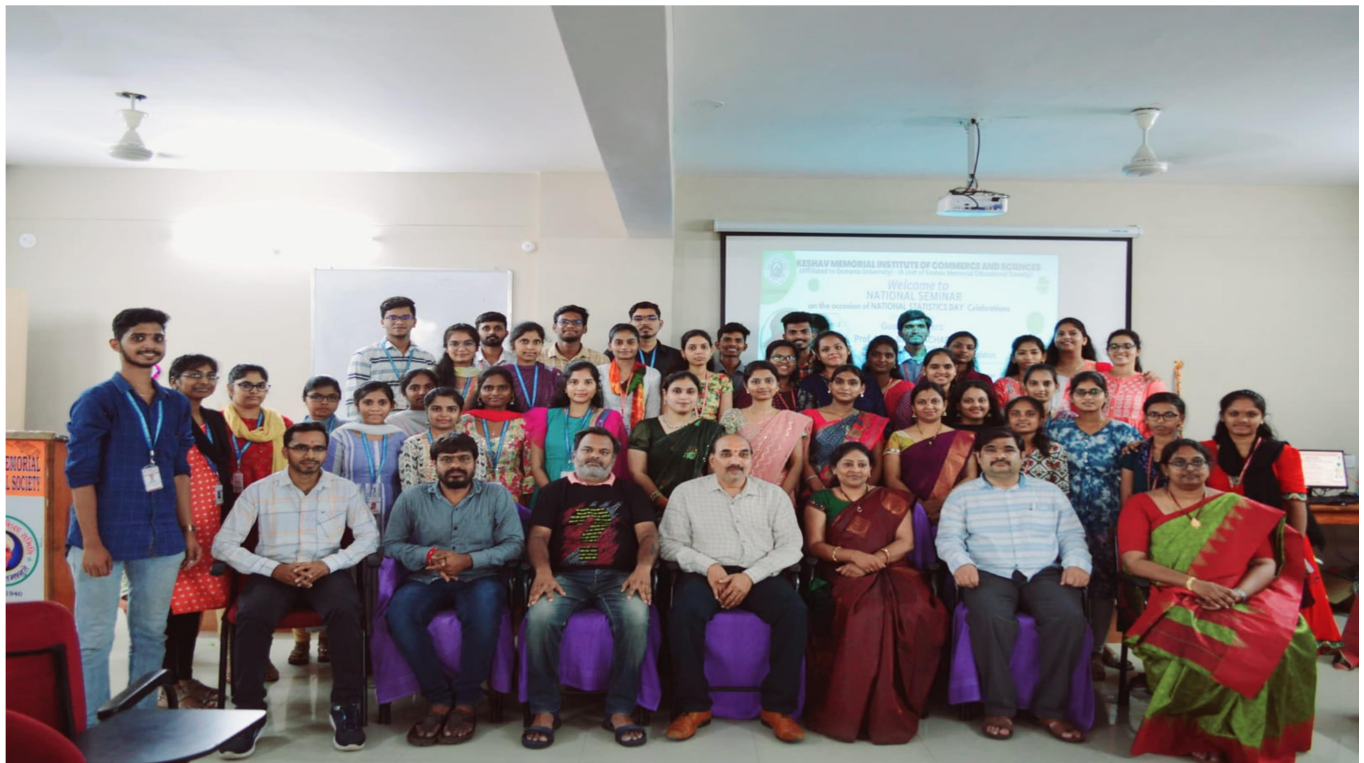
